



WHAT IS FISCAL SPONSORSHIP?

Fiscal sponsorship is when an existing nonprofit offers its services, support, and tax-exempt status to a community group or collaborative that wants to create a new program, build community movement, launch an initiative, or otherwise affect change for the common good. It's a mechanism to support people and organizations in creating new projects, without the need to create new nonprofits. Fiscal sponsors can offer a variety of services, from receipt of grants and charitable donations to technical assistance with project development. - Payments made from your fund may be exempt from Pennsylvania sales tax, where eligible.

- We maintain a responsive office, processing incoming donations and outgoing payments on a weekly schedule.



- You will be provided with detailed statements of your project activity, along with access to our online fund portal with information on fund balance and historic contributions, distributions, and statements.
- We offer extensive fundraising consulting and support, including access to our digital giving platforms to manage online appeal campaigns or event ticket and registration sales.
- Fees for fiscal sponsorship vary depending on the type of project but are typically 5 percent of each gift, grant, or contribution received for the project.
